Romaine Ashley Rendon Director of Consumer Services



For over fifteen years, Romaine Ashley Rendon has served NORA Electric Cooperative well. In January 2009. she started her career at NORA as a Consumer Services Representative. Later, she became the accounting clerk, and then in June 2020, she was promoted to her current position as Director of Consumer Services.

Some of the day-to-day responsibilities that Ashley manages are the oversight of the consumer services department and meter reading crew. She helps to ensure that the information collected from the meter readings is accurately recorded and communicated with the billing department. In the event of any discrepancies or issues with paperwork, she will help to resolve any outstanding concerns.

There are many facets to her role in overseeing the metering department. Rendon maintains an overview of all meters in the field, communicating with the crew making sure that all work orders for new service or repair are completed. One of their current long term projects

is the mapping of all existing meters and the preparation for the replacement of the PLX meters. Once the mapping of the meters is complete, this will be followed by the mapping of all poles and transformers across the service area.

Anther essential role that Rendon is responsible for is the supervision of NORA's time of use (TOU) program and the sale and maintenance of electric thermal storage (ETS) heating units. The TOU program lets members take advantage of using "off peak" hours when demand is lower, and less expensive, to consume the majority of their electricity and therefore save money. ETS units offer members a clean, safe, and affordable way to heat their homes efficiently.

Ashley is originally from Canjilon and a 2007 graduate of Escalante High School. In her free time, she enjoys spending time with her family and attending local football and basketball games. She is especially grateful for her mom, Audra Romero, who helps take care of her two daughters, Madison and Aubrey, ages ten and six, particularly when she is called to work after hours during outages.
