

Avoiding Late Fees & Disconnection Notices

In order to maintain uninterrupted service, it is imperative to make paying your electric and other utility bills on time a priority each month. NORA Electric Cooperative offers options to ensure your bill gets paid in a timely manner.

- ◆SurePay: SurePay is a complimentary service offered by NORA that provides the convenience of paying your bill automatically and on time each month. To enroll in the SurePay service, you must have an active checking or savings account, credit or debit card with any financial institution. An authorization form must be filled out and submitted to the NORA office. You can also download the form online at www.noraelectric.org. Once enrolled, the payment due will be automatically withdrawn five days before the due date on the current bill. Customers will continue to receive their monthly statement in the mail with itemized charges and payment information. Having the payment in on time prevents the unnecessary accumulation of late fees and the mailing out of late notices by the Co-op.
- ◆Online payment portal: Setting up a payment profile at noraelectric.org is quick and easy. You will need to enter your account number along with your personal information to create your user profile. Once your credentials are established, you can make on demand payments as needed.
- ◆ Quick Pay: One time payments can also be made online without setting up or logging into your payment profile. Simply choose Quick Pay. For this, you will still need to enter your account number and personal information.

Customers in need of financial assistance with utility bills are advised to contact the local Human Services Department Payment arrangements may also be negotiated with NORA on a case by case basis if necessary.
